

Zone selections

We are in good shape financially, but we have to keep a close eye on it. Jim Parr is our watchful Treasurer. At last count

we have \$50k in the bank which sounds good but just meets our needs. We need to have \$20k on hand to meet the possible costs of 2 teams to State pennant Finals, \$10k for large expenses — such as green renewal or major maintenance, and \$10k for working cash.

Unfortunately, registration fees are almost entirely consumed by capitation fees paid to Bowls NSW and Bowls Central Coast.

Of the \$10 green fees charged for a game \$8 goes to Club Ltd and the balance goes to Winners and Losers

Our financial success is due to 2 main inputs -

raffles lead by the indefatigable Les Puckeridge and Ian Hutchison with great support from other members when they are not available – and Sponsorship. Our major sponsors – Bendigo Bank, Creightons, Living Choice, Mitre 10 and Tyrepower - are ever helpful and responsive to our needs. Next month, we expect to announce a new major sponsor to join this list.
