This can occur in 2 separate circumstances - when 3rds (or 2nds in triples) are measuring, and when the Umpire is called - he or she owns the rink – so get out of the way.

New Sponsor




We are delighted to welcome **FlooringXtra** as a major sponsor. Their signage on the end of the Greenkeeper's shed
